## Student Personal Electronic Devices Policy

Student personal electronic devices (including, but not limited to, mobile phones, smart watches, smart glasses, and other wearable or portable electronic devices) are disruptive to instruction and learning and must be powered off during all class hours. This requirement applies at all times, including when leaving the classroom for restrooms or other areas within the Training Center.

Personal electronic devices may not be used as calculators, learning tools or recording devices during class. Devices may be used only during scheduled breaks or in case of an emergency. All devices must be powered off before re-entering the classroom following a break.

Work-related or Local Union calls should be made during scheduled breaks whenever possible. If a dispatch-related call cannot be made during a scheduled break, the student must request permission from the instructor prior to making the call during class time.

Any student found with a personal electronic device powered on during class will be **marked absent for the day**.
